Evolutions in legal services! I've heard it said in 8 weeks, our laws have advanced 8 years. Particularly, 3 weeks ago, the province issued two ministerial orders, [M161](#) and [M162](#), which allows Notaries to sign Wills, Enduring Powers of Attorneys, and Health Representation Agreements in the electronic presence of clients. Essentially, this means after doing our due diligence and initial interviews with clients, we watch them sign over audio-visual technology, such as Zoom. To date, we have signed remotely for four clients who all have serious, life threatening health issues who for safety reasons we cannot see in person. As long as the Emergency Order is in effect, we can essentially see people all over the province.

Couples moving in together or parents sharing a house with kids should consider cohabitation agreements.

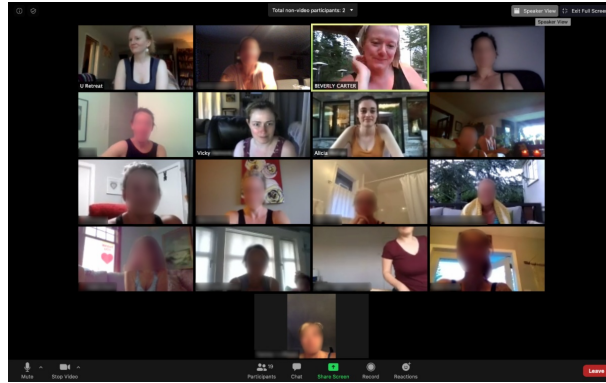
